 **Pets:** I've got a dog called Lucy. She's a whippet and can run very fast!

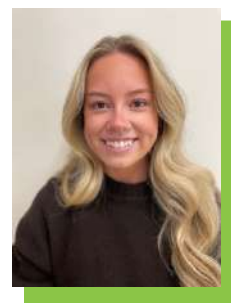
 **Favourite hobby:** My favourite thing to do is dance 🕺
