



Attendance Over One School Year

If a student had:

- 98% attendance = less than 4 days absent from school
- 95% attendance = less than 10 days absent from school
- 90% attendance = 4 weeks absent from school
- 85% attendance = 5½ weeks absent from school
- 80% attendance = 7½ weeks absent from school

COMMUNITY FUNDRAISER: HANNAH'S MEMORIAL GARDEN

Eccleston St Mary's CE Primary School is raising funds to create a memorial garden in memory of Hannah, a much-loved pupil who sadly passed away in November 2024 aged 8.

Hannah's classmates (now Year 5) have helped design the garden as a legacy to their friend, inspired by the things Hannah loved, her dog Izzy, rainbows, butterflies, the colour pink, dance, creativity and magic. The garden will be a peaceful, uplifting space for children to enjoy and remember.

With a contractor ready to begin work, the school is aiming to complete the garden by Spring, allowing Hannah's classmates to spend time there before moving on to high school. Thanks to generous community support, much has already been raised, but £5,000 is still needed.
