It has been hugely exciting to see the impact that the introduction of Opal Play has had at lunchtimes; the children are loving the wider choice of activites and resources that are now available to them. Thank you for all your donations so far which have made this possible.

The next phase of our plan is for the childen to begin to explore wider areas of the school grounds to play on, including the field, even when there is light rain. This will mean that they will need suitable clothing and footwear for when the weather is wet.
