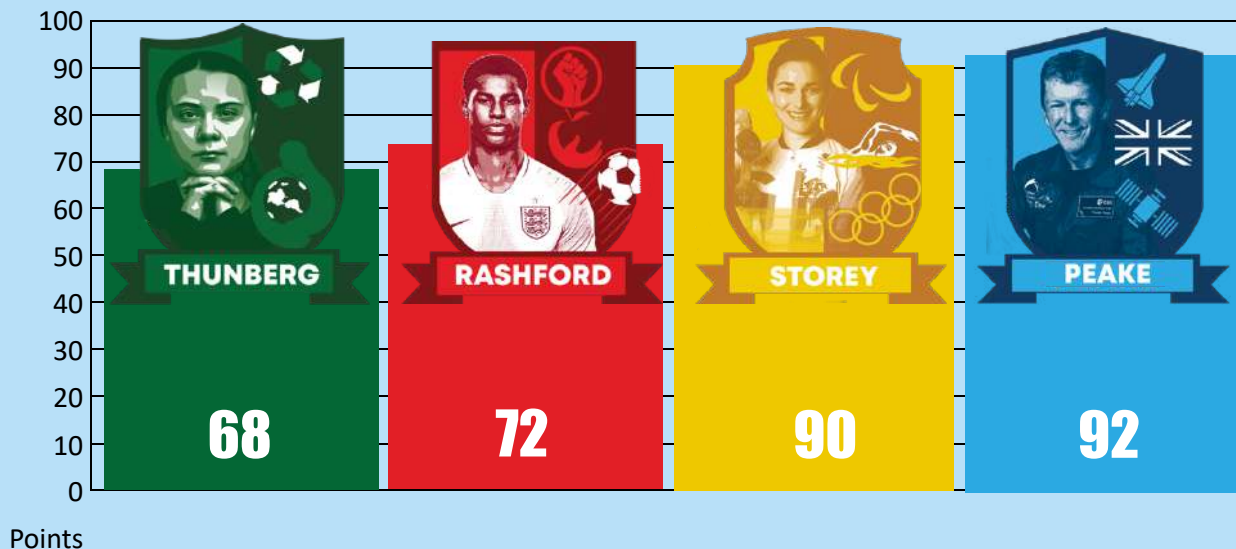

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Attendance Over One School Year

If a student had:

98% attendance = less than 4 days absent from school

95% attendance = less than 10 days absent from school

90% attendance = 4 weeks absent from school

85% attendance = 5½ weeks absent from school

80% attendance = 7½ weeks absent from school

Attendance over 4 year (Years 3-6)

If a student had:

85% attendance = having about half a year off school

80% attendance = having two whole terms off school
