

Wording of the question will need amending for next time as responses are not clear.


Continue to inform parents of any incidents that are bullying related. Inform governors of any bullying incidents that are reported.


Signpost parents to the website where 'Year Group Overviews' showcase the learning for the academic year.


Majority of comments are positive or that there have been no issues.




Wording of the question needs amending next time.




Signpost parents to 'End of Year Expectations' documents on the website to demonstrate our school's expectations.


New badges have been made for Stars of the Week to show how important this is to us – the children can then wear the badges all week and feel proud when they are reminded about their hard work.

Currently we hold two parents' evenings and write a formal end of year report.


Reassure parents that there is an open door policy for them to check in about their child.

There is a good range of subjects available to my child at Eccleston Primary School.






Continue to offer a wide range of clubs.


Continue to share key events at school, visiting speakers and assembly content.
