This week, Year 2 have been doing lots of practising — in maths and in our Christmas play! In maths, we've been working on our 2 and 10 times tables, playing fun games and competing on Hit the Button to earn points for our teams. Everyone has shown great enthusiasm and determination to get faster and more confident. We've also been busy rehearsing our Christmas play — learning lines, acting out scenes, singing songs and practising our dances. It's been lovely to see how much effort and excitement the children are putting into every part. They say "practice makes perfect" — and after this week, Year 2 are definitely proving it!









This week the Reception children have been on an autumn walk around our school grounds. We chatted about the changes we could expect to see in the autumn and talked about changes in the colour of the leaves and what animals do at this time of year. We were also lucky to find some interesting fungi in our nursery garden.







In Year 4, we started our DT unit all about designing and making Christmas cards. In our first lesson, we learned what a design brief is and created our own. We then explored a range of light-up card examples, evaluating their features and discussing the pros and cons of each design. Over the next few weeks, we will be putting our ideas into practice as we design and create our very own Christmas light-up cards. We can't wait to share the finished products!







In Nursery this week we have continued to talk about night and day and had wonderful fun with the parachute in the big hall. The children had to identify if the image on the poster was daytime or nighttime, they sat on top of the parachute for daytime and went under it for nighttime. We acted out the story of What Ever Next, where the children took turns in acting out different events from the story. In maths, the children focused on recognising when they see a number one by showing this on their finger and singing "1 finger 1 thumb", we then decorated number ones and practiced writing a number one too. Some children practiced their colours using our colour coding game, they did so well recognising the colours and sorting the objects correctly. Well done to all our children!

Year 1 have been busy in Computing this week, exploring a range of creative tools on Paintz.app. They experimented with features such as the airbrush and paintbrush to get used to how the programme works. Using their new skills, the children then created their own digital self-portraits, applying what they had learned to paint their faces.
