This week in Year 2, we have been exploring the properties of 3D shapes. The children have learned the names of a range of 3D shapes and investigated their features, including how many faces, vertices and edges each one has.

We also explored what the nets of these shapes look like and how they fold together to form 3D shapes. The children particularly enjoyed having a go at making their own cubes, using their knowledge of nets to construct them carefully.

It has been a fantastic week of hands-on learning, with lots of curiosity and great mathematical thinking on show.
