

Year 2 Summer 2 Curriculum Map

Theme: Science - Go Wild!

SCIENCE: Living Things, Habitats and Plants

Go Wild enquiry questions: living/dead/never alive; healthiest plant; bean growth; animal adaptations; food chains.

Scientist focus: Dr Alexandra Harmon-Threatt.

Children will group living things, explore habitats, grow and observe beans, investigate plant needs, learn about adaptations and build simple food chains.

English



The Tempest: descriptions, spells and story writing using expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, subordination, suffixes and progressive tenses.

Geography

Local enquiry: Is Knutsford a good place for children to play and visit? Human/physical features, opinions and child-friendly places.

DT



Textile puppets: practise sewing, choose materials, join fabric carefully and evaluate puppet designs.

Maths



Volume and capacity, plus a recap of Year 2 number, calculation, shape, measure and reasoning.

PSHE



Kapow Economic Wellbeing: money, bank cards, wants and needs, skills/talents, equality and inclusion.

RE



Buddhism: beliefs, respect, calm reflection and the teachings of Buddha.

Music



Recorders: read simple patterns, play with control, listen carefully and perform together.

PE



Striking and fielding: batting, throwing, catching, fielding and teamwork.
