### Our Theme – The Great Fire of London

This half term, our learning is centred around the exciting theme of The Great Fire of London, which we will explore through English, History and Music.

In English, children will use the story The Great Fire of London by E. Adams to inspire diary entries, recounts and descriptive writing, developing their sentence accuracy and vocabulary.

In History, pupils will investigate what happened in 1666 by studying real evidence, sequencing events on a timeline and discovering why the fire spread so quickly, including the lasting impact it had on London.

In Music, children will learn and perform songs linked to the Great Fire and create their own dramatic compositions inspired by the events of the time. Together, these subjects give children a rich and engaging understanding of this significant moment in history.
