PE

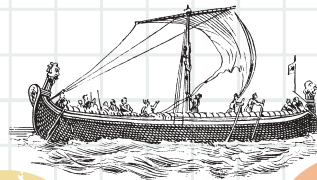
Our focus this half term will be

MATHS

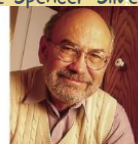
Number and Place Value
Children will learn to:

- Read, write, order and compare numbers to 1 million.
- Count forwards and backwards in steps of powers of 10.
- Interpret negative numbers in context, counting forwards and backwards with positive and negative whole numbers.
- Round any number up to 1 million to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10000 and 100000.

- Give reasons from evidence based research for the particular uses of everyday materials.
