Science

In their science learning this half term the children will:

- Explore and compare the differences between things that are dead, alive and have never been alive.
- Identify that most living things live in a habitat to which they are suited and describe how they are suited to their environment.
- Identify and name a variety of animals and plants in their habitats, including microhabitats.

Design & Technology

In D&T the children are going to be creating their own puppets. They will plan out their design by choosing their favourite animal. They will then use different materials and stitching skills to join fabric and add embellishment to create their finished product.

Music

In music the children will continue their recorders project with Love, Music, trust to learn 2 different notes and how to read simple music from a stave.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths, the children are going to review all of their knowledge from the Year 2 curriculum. They will also learn how to:

- Recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4 and 3/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.
- Write simple fractions for example, 1/2 of 6 = 3 and recognise the equivalence of 2/4 and 1/2.
- Tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.
- Know the number of minutes in an hour.

Computing

Our computing units this half term are:

- Creating Pictures
 - Presenting Ideas

The children will learn about different types of art and artists, and use 2Paint to make their own pictures in these styles. They will also explore how to use Purple Mash to design and present information.

<u>History</u>
