What is Safeguarding about?

All of the adults around you think that your health, safety and welfare are very important. In our school, we respect our children and help to protect their rights. We do our best to help children make good educational progress. We teach children how to recognise risks in different situations and how to protect themselves and stay safe.

How will we try to protect children?

We try to provide a safe environment for our children to learn in. We want to help to ensure that children remain safe at home, online and at school. We think it is important for our children to know where to get help if they are worried or unhappy about something.

Need to talk?

You can talk to any adult at school if you need to, but Mrs Lowe, Mrs Sedgwick, and Miss Renton's special jobs are to make sure everyone feels happy and safe, if you want to talk to any of them you can, at any time. We also have a Year 6 Health and Safety Team who are responsible for being a voice for you to ensure that you feel safe and are happy in school.

What Will Happen if You Tell Us Something

We will listen carefully to you.

We will take what you say seriously.

We will do our best to help and keep you safe.

Sometimes we may need to tell other trusted adults so they can help too.
