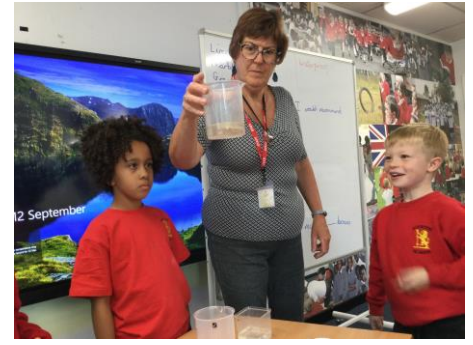
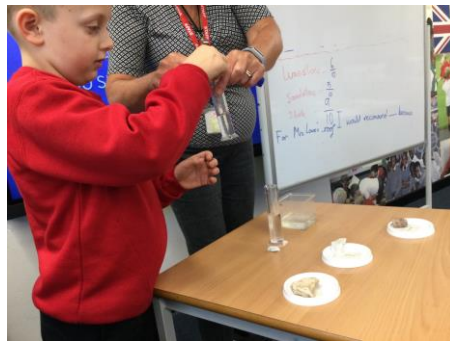

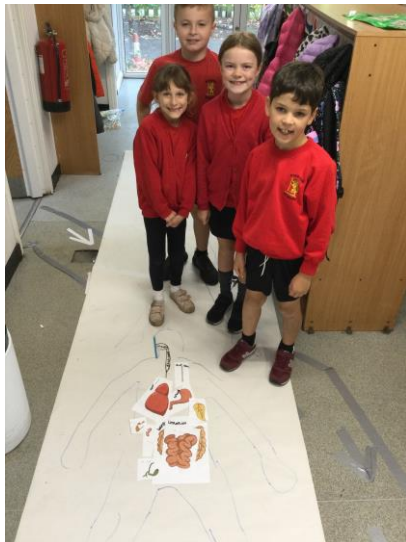

Class 1 have been busy scientists this week exploring everyday materials.
