

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will explore colour mixing with paints. They will be encouraged to mix the paint to make new colours and watch the changes. Teaching staff will support children as they do this and engage in conversation with them about what they see.

Children will listen to different pieces of music and have the opportunity to dance along. They will express how it makes them feel along with what they like and dislike about the music itself.

Children are able to draw and write in the classroom and outside independently. They can play with craft resources and playdough and use their imagination to build and design alongside their friends.

Physical Development

Children have access to resources such as spinning chairs and rockers, wobble boards, soft play and bikes.

Children will be encouraged to mark make using chalk, paint, crayons and felt tips. They will have supervised access to scissors, hole punches and stencils.

Maths

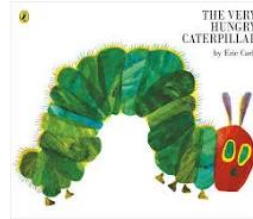
Children will be learning songs such as 5 Little Speckled Frogs and 5 Current Buns to develop counting skills.

Understanding the World

Plants and Growing

Children will learn that green beans, flowers and vegetables can be grown from seeds and beans. Plants are grown from bulbs. To look after a bulb or a seed, we must give it soil, water and light. A seed will grow into a plant. A plant has roots and a stem. New vocabulary they will discover: Seeds, bulbs, soil, water, light, plant, roots stem and leaves

Lifecycles

Children will learn butterflies undergo a life cycle change and are only butterflies at the end of the cycle. There are 4 stages of the life

Recycling

Children will learn rubbish goes in the bin or the recycling bin. Recycle means to re-use. They will learn ways in which they can recycle at school and home.

Literacy

Children will begin learning the letters s,a,t,p,i,n and importantly the sounds they make. They will continue writing their name with increasing accuracy.
