

Understanding the World

Children will learn about the growing of different vegetables. They will know the difference between seeds and bulbs and that they grow into flowers, plants and trees. Fruit and vegetables grow in the ground, on plants and in trees. Children will also learn about the different parts of a plant.

We will continue our learning on vegetables and children will compare the growing of plants in different countries. They will know that hotter countries will grow a wider variety of plants.

Children will also look at life cycles. They will know a life cycle is the stages something goes through during its life. The life cycle the children will learn about will be a butterfly.

Physical Development

In PE this term children will focus on team building games. The children will understand how to work as a team in different sports and games to help their team win. The children will play games that promote the use of good team communication so they can work together better.

Maths

The children will explore sharing and grouping using concrete resources and continuous provision. They will also make their own repeating pattern and come up with their own pattern rule. The children will be given lots of opportunities to consolidate their Reception learning ready for Year 1

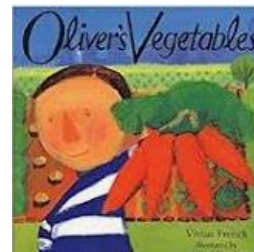
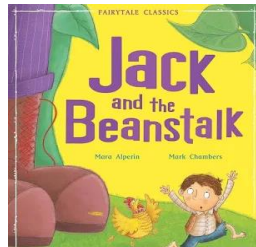

Communication and Language

Children are exposed to a vocabulary rich environment and will continue to learn new vocabulary in relation to our topic and during Drawing Club each week.

Tapestry is a fantastic tool for developing our communication as children enjoy sharing pictures with their friends, holding conversations and asking questions around them.

PSED

Children will learn about the importance of working together in a team and the importance of supporting your team. We will discuss how being a good sport when we win or lose is important and respectful.

Children will begin to get ready for the transition from Reception to Year 1 and discuss their feelings about moving to their new classes.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will think about what they need to make sandwiches for them to make their own egg and cress sandwich with their homegrown cress. The children will role play as doctors to support their learning on being healthy. The children will create a butterfly oil pastel picture for their learning on lifecycles.

Literacy

Children will continue to take part in daily phonics lessons, building on their previous learning. Children will be being to learn to read polysyllabic words and use them in their writing. The children will consolidate their previous learning to ensure they are secure in their taught sounds and high frequency words.

Children will join drawing club this term and be introduced to a wide range of book each week and will become more independent writing sentences around the books.
