

Design and Technology

In DT we will be designing and making cereal bars. First, we will learn what a cereal bar is. Then we will look at different healthy ingredients we can use to design and make the bars.

Music

In music we will reflect, rewind and replay the learning we have focused on over the year and we will continue to develop our understanding of appraising the songs we have learnt.

PE

In PE we will be developing our skills to move at speed in a variety of ways, ensuring we can change direction effectively. We will learn athletic skills including jumping, running and throwing techniques.

RE

In R.E., your child will be learning about a variety of places of worship. They will retrieve their knowledge of religions covered this year linking to places of worship.

Science

In science we will be learning about the changes across the four seasons. We will also describe measure and record weather across the four seasons.

We will continue developing our phonic skills by following the Monster Phonics programme.
