### Road Safety

We have been made aware of some behavioural issues outside the school gates before school opening. We would like to remind all parents of the following:

- If your child travels to school on a bike or a scooter it is important to talk to them about road safety and how they should behave outside of school.
- All children at Elliston have been provided with a bike helmet which they should always wear when riding their bike or scooter.
- School gates will not open until 8.45am at the earliest, please do not send your child to school earlier than this.
- You must not park on the yellow lines outside of school between 8 and 9am and 3 and 4pm. Due to our staggered start and finish times we ask that you consider this as an extension to the times when it is unsafe to park here.

We are also aware of children's behaviour in the playground at the end of the day, we must remind all parents that children should be collected by parents and walk chatting, this is to continue to keep everyone Covid safe straight off the school site, we cannot allow running around the playground or standing around chatting, this is to continue to keep everyone Covid safe.
