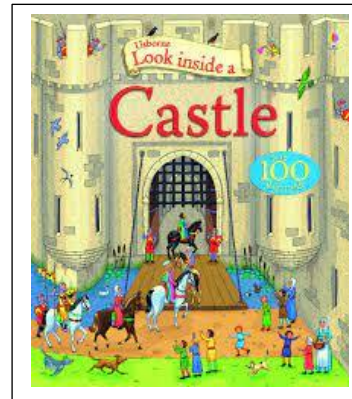
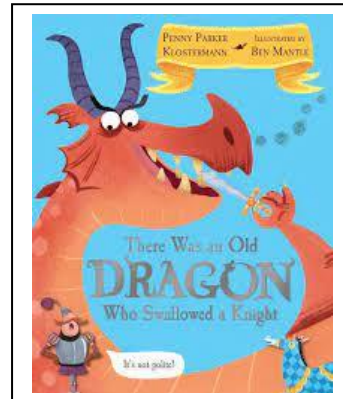

### Key Questions

1. What is the capital city of England?
2. Who is the King of England?
3. What does a king do?
4. Does the King of England live in a castle?
5. Does the King have a dragon?



### Maths

We will be mastering our knowledge of numbers up to five, investigating one more and one less.

We will explore shape, their properties and develop our mathematical vocabulary in relation to these concepts.

### PSED

Children will discuss different types of feelings and as a group, children will begin to talk about how they could manage their feelings.

### Expressive Arts and Design

The craft area will be set up with materials to encourage children make their very own castles. In music, your child will be exploring the stories that songs and music can tell by learning 6 new nursery rhyme and action songs. Your child will respond to the songs, considering how it made them feel and by identifying instruments heard. Children will be encouraged to role play the different jobs in a castle.

### Literacy

We will be reading the fiction book 'There Was an Old Dragon Who Swallowed a Knight' and various non-fiction books to collect facts and information about Castles.

Children will begin to read a few simple sentences independently using their Monster Phonics reading books. They will be encouraged to write cvc words using the phonetic knowledge they have learnt so far.
