School Uniform



Uniform

- Purple sweatshirt or cardigan with embroidered school logo.
- White cotton shirt/blouse for Year 6 children.
- Tie for Year 6 children.
- White polo shirt for Nursery to Year 5 children.
- Black or Grey trousers.
- Black or Grey skirt.
- Black shoes are preferred rather than trainers. If trainers are worn, they must be black and as plain as possible. (No Astroturf trainers please).
- No heels.
- No jeans, no joggers or jogging bottoms (Joggers are allowed in Nursery).

PE Kit

- White round neck t-shirt.
- Black shorts.
- Black plimsolls/trainers.

A change of clothing is required for PE including a change of footwear. This must be kept in school in a bag of a reasonable size and of a soft material.

All school clothes should be named
