<u>Topic</u>

Science - Your child will be exploring what materials different objects are made from. The children will be able to describe the properties of these materials and carry out some investigations to test the most effective. Geography - The children will learn the 7 continents and 5 oceans. They will learn where Brazil is and compare life in Brazil to their own lives using their knowledge of human and physical features.

Music

In music we will be learning a new song and learning some notes to play on the Glockenspiel. We will be learning to keep to a beat.

<u>RE</u>

In RE this term, we will be learning the Christian creation story, and this influences how Christians behave towards nature and the environment.

Physical, Emotional Health and Well Being

The children will learn about the different people who care for them and how families are different. We will also be learning about kind and unkind behaviour and the qualities that make a good friend.

<u>Maths:</u>

In Year 1, your child will be reading, write, order and comparing numbers to 10. They will learn number bonds of 5 and understand odd and even numbers. They will learn how to represent numbers in different ways including using manipulatives and pictures.

In year 2, your child will be learning to partition 2 digit numbers into tens and ones. They will be learning different ways to represent their maths, including using concrete pictoral and abstract methods.

Literacy and Communication

In English, your child will be reading the book The Lonely Beast. We will be making predictions prior to reading the book and using the pictures to infer what may be happening. There will be opportunity to write for specific purposes such as writing a setting description and a narrative.
