The Sensory Bus



The Linkage Sensory Bus is the main part of the Linkage's Outreach Project. It's a fully- accessible converted bus offering individuals and groups the opportunity to access and benefit from a sensory room at no cost.

This unique space can be adapted and customised according to the needs of the users; we can make it a calm and relaxing environment or a stimulating interactive space. We primarily work with mainstream schools which have a proportion of children with SEND but we also visit care homes, special schools, nurseries and children's centres.

The Sensory Bus will visit your school or care setting for a taster day so you can see how those you work with/care for respond to it. It will then visit once a week for 6 weeks.

The Sensory Library



Our sensory library gives people the opportunity to borrow sensory resources at no cost. Think of us as a 'try before you buy' service. Find out what works for you/someone you care for before making an investment in expensive equipment.

There can be many benefits of using sensory equipment including:

- **Relaxation**
- **Creating a safe space**
- **Increasing communication and interaction**
- **Reducing anxiety**

Lego®- based Therapy Training



Our Development Workers offer free training to schools in the delivery of Lego®-based Therapy.

They will visit the setting once a week for 6 weeks to deliver Lego®-based therapy sessions to a group of children alongside teachers/ support staff. School staff will learn how to turn the fun and imaginative pastime of Lego® into an exciting, challenging, structured and engaging learning session. Benefits include increases in:

- **Social skills**
