



## Re-Opening Information for whole school

In light of the government announcement that schools will reopen we are delighted to welcome to all pupils back to Elliston from 8<sup>th</sup> March.

### Social Distancing measures

**These will be expected by anyone coming to Elliston and on the way home from Elliston. Signage will indicate waiting and walking areas for adults and children. Staff will be on hand each morning to ensure these are understood and followed. Please follow the guidance about start and finish times strictly.**

### Entry to school

Breakfast club – the large gate on Bramhall Street and drop off at the Hall doors

Reception – the small gate on Bramhall Street

Year 1, 2, 3 & 4 – the large gate on Elliston Street into the playground

Year 5 & 6 - the small gate on Elliston Street

Please **only** arrive at the times below according to your child's surname. We ask that only one adult drops off and picks up children where possible and there should be no waiting or standing around in the playground. All entrances around school are signposted. All visitors to enter school site **MUST** wear a face covering.

### Reminders

If you or your child displays any symptoms of COVID-19, as identified by the Government, **do not attempt to come to school**. Ring the school office and we will be able to advise you of testing processes. Isolation guidance will apply for unless a negative test result is secured. Any child taken ill with COVID-19 symptoms in school will go to an isolation room and you will need to collect him/her plus siblings immediately.
