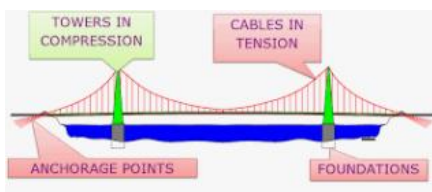
#### What is the Golden Gate Bridge?



The Golden Gate bridge is a suspension bridge that links San Francisco to Marin County. It opened in 1937 and Joseph Strauss designed it. There is an \$8 toll to cross the bridge.

#### What is a suspension bridge?

A suspension bridge is a type of bridge where the deck is hung below using suspension cables on vertical suspenders.
