Behaviour of adults on school site and on social media

You may be aware that we have had some incidents with parents/carers being aggressive and/or using inappropriate language on school site. We apologise if your children have been subjected to this while being in the vicinity of any such incidents. We want to reassure you that we do not tolerate such behaviour. Any acts of aggression and bad language is treated very seriously and, where necessary, we use school site bans and police involvement and will continue to do so for the safety and well-being of our children, staff and parents.

This view on appropriate and respectful behaviour also extends to social media. Any

derogatory comments that name school, children or staff will be also be taken very

seriously. The following is from the Trust regarding this matter.

The Enquire Learning Trust and Elliston Primary Academy take the inappropriate use of social media by parents/ carers very seriously. The Trust considers the use of social media websites being used in this way as unacceptable and not in the best interests of the children or the whole school community.

In the event that any pupil or parent/carer of a child/ren being educated at Elliston Primary Academy is found to be posting libellous or defamatory comments on Facebook or other social network sites, they will be reported to the appropriate 'report abuse' section of the network site. All social network sites have clear rules about the content which can be posted on the site and they provide robust mechanisms to report contact or activity which breaches this.
