

What did the Wright brothers achieve?

The Wright brothers invented, built and flew the world's first successful airplane in 1903.

What did Thomas Andrews achieve?

Titanic was designed by Thomas Andrews in 1909 and built in the city of Belfast. It first began construction in March 1909 and was launched in May 1911 What did Amy Johnson achieve?

Amy Johnson was the first female to fly solo from London to Australia in 1930

How long did it take the Wright Brothers to create the first aeroplane?

It took the Wright Brothers 6 years to design and build the first successful aeroplane (1899-1905)

How big was the Titanic?

The Titanic was 269.6 metres long and was seen to be the largest ship of its time.

How long was the journey Amy Johnson made from London to Australia?

The flight journey was around 11000 miles and took 19 days to complete- Beginning on May 5th 1930 and ending May 24th 1930.



Where in the United Kingdom is Hull?

Hull is a port city in the East Riding of Yorkshire.

It is Amy Johnson's place of birth.



Where in the United Kingdom is Belfast?

Belfast is a city found in Northern Ireland
