



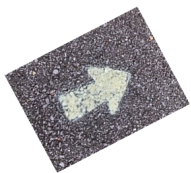
Wider opening of school

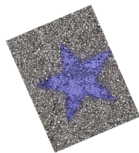
Coming into school is an adventure!

When you get to school, see if you can find

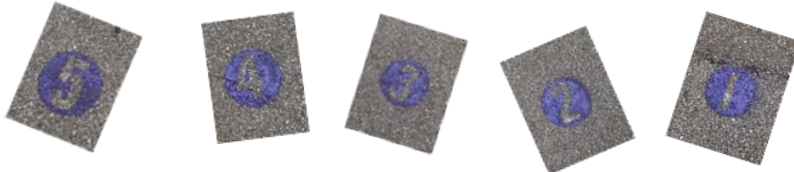


Arrows showing you the right way to walk
