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Ofsted revisit. Letter to parent carers



You may be aware that we have been expecting an Ofsted/ Care Quality Commission (CQC) Special Educational Needs and Disabilities revisit of North East Lincolnshire Council following on from their initial inspection in July 2018.

This week we have been notified that the revisit will take place from Monday 21 to Wednesday 23 March 2022.

Parent carers are invited to be involved in the inspection process.

You will see that Ofsted are interested in the Written Statement of Action. This is a document that was created from their observations during their last visit.
