Handle sources and ask and answer questions on the past using the basis of simple observation.

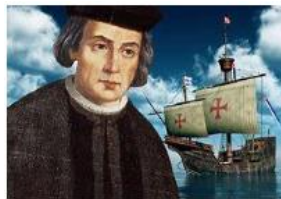

Timeline – Christopher Columbus

<p>1451 Christopher Columbus was an explorer born in 1451 in Genoa, Northern Italy.</p>	<p>1485 He arrived in Spain</p>	<p>August 3rd, 1492 Christopher Columbus believed the Earth was round and decided to try to sail west from Europe to reach Asia. Three ships sailed west called the Santa Maria, the Nina and the Pinta.</p>	<p>12th October 1492 Columbus landed in the Bahamas. He called this place the 'New World'. He also found an island and named it San Salvador.</p>	<p>Columbus went on four voyages across the Atlantic Ocean.</p>	<p>1506 Columbus became ill and died. He never knew he had found a new continent, North America.</p>

<p>1930 Neil Armstrong was born in Ohio, USA.</p>	<p>1962 He began training to be an astronaut.</p>	<p>1967 United States scientists began making plans for a moon landing and designed a new spacecraft called Apollo.</p>	<p>1969 Apollo 11 was launched from the Kennedy Space Centre in Florida. It was the first spacecraft to land on the moon.</p>	<p>21st July, 1969 Neil Armstrong was the first person to walk on the moon.</p>	<p>2012 He died in Ohio, USA.</p>
