## Job opportunity- Data Support Officer (SEND)

There are 2 posts available, they are grant funded posts – fixed term for 2 years.

### **Data Support Officer (SEND)**

The Delivering Better Value programme (DBV) is a national programme led by the Department for Education (DfE). The focus is Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).

The purpose of the programme: to work with local authorities with SEND responsibilities to look at ways of improving local services, making the most effective use of resources and, most importantly, improving outcomes for children.

The programme includes considering how data and insights can be used to better inform trend analysis, planning, decision making and service design, working with and alongside children and families; and how schools can work together more effectively to support an inclusive approach to education provision and support.

### **Your Role & Team**

This is a new role within our new Insights team that is responsible for the collection, collation, and analysis of data and information for the DBV project.

In this role you will collate and gather information from a wide range of sources and systems across the council and its partners. You will ensure that information is accessible to the data analysts working within the team, ensuring that data is 'clean' and of a high quality, and undertake some data analysis yourself.
