What we are learning:

About what is a structure as well as what decides whether a structure is mega or not. We will also be learning about the country of Italy, including its different geographical and human features. In addition, we will be closely looking at famous Italian structures and evaluating whether they are mega.

Key Questions: Where is Italy? What is a structure? Can you name some famous structures found in Italy? What is the capital city of Italy? What currency do people in Italy use?

Presentation of Learning

We will be showcasing our learning in a variety of ways including structure models that have been produced and samples of food that originate from Italy.

Year 3 children will be learning to recognise order, compare and represent numbers in different ways.
