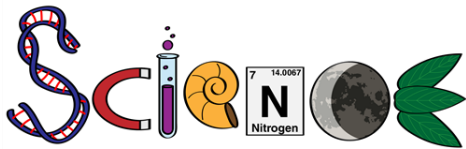


OUR CLASS TRIPS

Transport
