Updates to the ECF Programme

From September, Embrace will only offer the ECTE programme for new ECTs with the National Institute of Teaching. This is to improve the experience for all ECTs, Mentors and Induction Tutors.

The NIOT programme required ECTs to be out of school less and enabled more localised delivery and collaboration, reducing travel time for many ECTs/ Mentors, whilst enabling secondary ECTs to join Lancashire subject networks.

A series of briefings were held for all Induction Tutors who currently have ECTs with Teach First outlining the key points, notably:

- All current Primary ECTs will complete Year 2 on the existing Teach First Programme, delivered by Embrace.
- New ECTs starting in 2025/26 will join the NIOT programme, delivered by
