Allocating ECTs and Mentors to cohorts takes time, as we check everyone's post code and attempt to reduce travel where possible. <u>Complete this form</u> as soon as possible if your Year 1 ECT is staying with you into Year 2, or is leaving.

It is likely that Year 1 cohorts will be local and cross phase, supporting the development of local networks and Year 2 will continue to be subject/ phase specific - however this depends on the number of ECTs recruited in the region.
