PSHE

Rule of Law

- PSHE explicitly teaches that rules and laws keep people safe, linking classroom expectations to wider community and national laws (e.g., safety online, road safety, anti-bullying).
- Scenarios and role-play help pupils explore fairness, consequences and responsibility, developing an understanding of justice and why consistent rules protect rights.
- Lessons on digital citizenship and respect for property reinforce ethical behaviour (e.g., honesty, consent, crediting others' work) and the importance of following agreed codes.

Individual Liberty

- PSHE builds children's self-knowledge and confidence, enabling them to make informed choices about health, friendships, online behaviour and learning.
- Teaching about personal safety, consent and boundaries empowers pupils to recognise their rights and take responsibility for their actions.
- Careers, aspirations and goal-setting activities encourage pupils to explore their interests and strengths, make independent decisions and understand how choices shape their future.

Democracy

- Circle time, class charters and class councils give pupils regular opportunities to share ideas, listen to others and participate in decisions that affect their learning and wellbeing.
- Structured discussion, debate and restorative conversations teach children to express opinions respectfully, consider evidence and reach agreed solutions together.
- Pupil-voice activities help pupils understand that everyone's voice matters and that their input can lead to change.

Respect & Tolerance

- PSHE develops empathy by exploring similarities and differences between people, challenging stereotypes and celebrating diversity in modern Britain.
- Lessons on respectful relationships, kindness and inclusion help pupils value others' perspectives, manage conflict and respond to disagreement constructively.
- Anti-bullying education (including prejudice-based bullying) and bystander strategies equip pupils to stand up for others, fostering a respectful, safe school community.
