FBV through Maths

Rule of Law

Through mathematics at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of the rule of law by providing opportunities for pupils to:

- follow rules when playing maths games
- learn and apply rules in calculations, number and geometry.

Individual Liberty

Through mathematics at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of individual liberty by:

- encouraging the children to select equipment and methods independently when working mathematically
- enabling pupils to have opportunities to make mistakes and learn from them.
- using problem solving as a context for pupils to take risks.

Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Mathematics at Endeavour Academy promotes the British value of mutual respect and tolerance through opportunities for pupils to:

- share with their peers methods of solving problems. Pupils are encouraged to provide each other with feedback, ensuring that they review each other's work respectfully.
- work together to support each other and build mutual respect for one another.
- work collaboratively on projects/problems and use peer assessment and feedback to progress learning in mathematics

Democracy

Mathematics at Endeavour Academy promotes the British value of democracy through:

- pupil voice opportunities where pupils are able to articulate their views on the mathematics curriculum and the teaching of maths;
- taking into account the views of others and learning about democracy through voting when collecting data to analyse.
- taking turns to listen to everyone speak and give their answers and explanations.
