FBV through PSHE

Rule of Law

Through the PSHE curriculum at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of the rule of law by:

- teaching pupils to recognise their place within society and understand their rights and responsibilities as a member of their class, school, local community, as a citizen of the UK and also as a global citizen.

Individual Liberty

Through PSHE at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of individual liberty by:

- helping pupils identify the practicalities of careers and that the future holds many opportunities. Similarly, children learn that these opportunities are not always offered to others (other cultures) and that they must take advantage of those offered up

Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Through PSHE at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of mutual respect and tolerance by:

- teaching pupils to recognise that assumptions, based on what someone may look like, can be made due to the influences that surround us
- teaching pupils that differences, including cultural and racial differences, can cause conflict and that bullying has many forms including direct and indirect bullying
- teaching pupils that 'normal' is a perception and that disability can affect this

Democracy

Through PSHE at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of democracy by:

- educating pupils on their rights and personal freedoms as well as supporting them in recognising how to exercise these freedoms safely
