## FBV through RE

### Rule of Law

Through RE at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of the rule of law by:

- examining different codes for living;
- exploring the need to have rules both in and out of school and the need to always do the right thing;
- providing pupils with opportunities to think about the laws, commandments and expectations within a faith and how those rules would impact on their own lives as well as on the lives of the people within those religions.

### Individual Liberty

Through RE at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of individual liberty by:

- fostering the idea that individuals have freedom to choose what they believe;
- giving pupils the opportunity to explore, gain knowledge and to reach an understanding that people are at liberty to choose how they express their faith and what they believe in.

### Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Through RE at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of mutual respect and tolerance by:

- challenging pupils to be increasingly respectful and to celebrate diversity of different cultures, faiths and beliefs;
- encouraging pupils to use their developing knowledge to spot and challenge intolerance when they see it for example, in the media.

### Democracy

Through RE at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of democracy by:

- encouraging pupils to express their views in a safe and respectful environment, encouraging all children to listen to and respect the views of others even if contrary to their own.
- supporting pupils to develop their own voice and informed opinions
