


SUPPORTING GOOD ATTENDANCE: PHARMACY FIRST

WHAT IS PHARMACY FIRST?



Pharmacy First is an NHS service that allows local pharmacists to provide expert advice and treatment for common illnesses without the need for a GP appointment. This means your child can get the care they need quickly and return to school sooner.

HOW CAN I ACCESS TREATMENT FROM MY PHARMACY?



You can get treatment by walking into the pharmacy. The pharmacist will be able to speak to you and your child privately in a separate consultation room. They may perform an examination or ask to access your child's medical records. The pharmacist will be able to recommend the best course of action on an individual patient basis, including by issuing prescriptions where necessary.

Faster Treatment:

No need to wait for a GP appointment; visit a participating pharmacy instead.

Common Illnesses Covered:

Pharmacists can help with sore throats, ear infections, insect bites, impetigo and more.
