

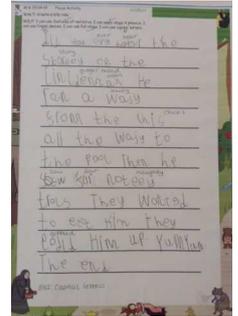

What been happening in School?

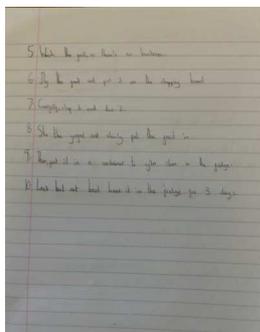
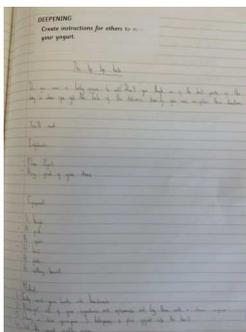


In Nursery, we have been studying 'Oliver's Vegetables' and have created a wonderful art display. The children mixed colours to paint the fruit and vegetables after looking at real examples. This was a follow up to us planting vegetable seeds earlier in the topic. We then enjoyed reading 'Farmer Duck' which led us to discuss sharing our workloads.

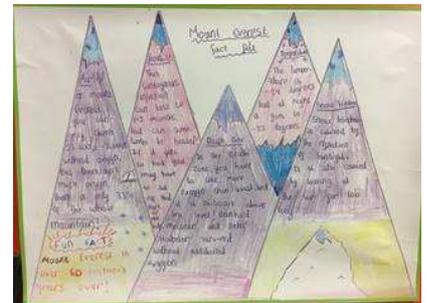
In Reception, we have been extending our learning about fairy tales and have been writing our own silly tales. The children spun the story wheel to dictate where their story would go next, resulting in some very funny tales. The children had to ensure they had a beginning, middle and end. All the children tried hard to remember capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and used a high level of phonics. The children then shared their stories in a group session.



In KS1 we have been learning about what makes up a balanced and varied diet. We have been looking at the food groups; what they are and how much of each group we should be eating. We have been trying to create a healthy pizza! We have been designing our 'Perfect Pizzas' that are healthy, varied and most importantly...delicious! We look forward to doing some bread and topping tasting.



In LKS2 we have just come to the end of our Design & Technology unit. We have enjoyed investigating, designing and creating our own yoghurt creations. After creating our yoghurts we created a set of instructions to advise others how they could make one. It has been fabulous that we have been hearing that some children have extended their learning and have created alternative flavoured yoghurts.



In Upper Key Stage Two the children explored Mount Everest. They researched key facts and produced a fact file on their findings.
