FBV through Music

Rule of Law

Through music at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of the rule of law by providing opportunities for pupils to:

- learn the rules of music such as creating and maintaining a beat, reading a graphic score, singing with control, listening and appraising music and playing instruments and recognise the impact and consequences when rules are not followed

Individual Liberty

Through music at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of individual liberty by:

- encouraging the children to listen to and accept the views of others when discussing musical styles, likes or dislikes;
- teaching pupils to accept that opinions and tastes are subjective and that differences of opinions are valid and equal to their own.

Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Through music at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of mutual respect and tolerance by:

- pupils working together in music lessons to compose and arrange their own music in pairs or small groups and understanding the need to listen to each other's opinions and ideas to create harmonious music.
- teaching pupils the skill of listening to others when playing or singing together so that all voices and instruments work and blend together to create the required sound or effect.
- teaching pupils how to listen to and appraise the performances of their peers, offering constructive criticism in a respectful and positive way.
- exposing pupils to a wide range of musical styles and genres from around the world

Democracy

Through Music at Endeavour Academy we promote the British value of democracy by:

- providing opportunities for pupils to choose their own instruments, rhythms and songs and vote to make decisions when working as part of a group.
