Rule of Law

The Spanish curriculum at Endeavour Academy promotes the British Value of the rule of law by:

• teaching pupils the rules for learning Spanish and encouraging pupils to apply them enables pupils gain a clear understanding that rules have a purpose, are set for good reasons and must be adhered to.

Individual Liberty

The Spanish curriculum at Endeavour Academy promotes the British Value of individual liberty for example:

- within speaking and listening activities, pupils are given opportunities to discuss viewpoints and are encouraged to show respect towards others.
- they work within boundaries to make safe choices during all activities and develop their own justified opinions about the country and its culture.

Mutual Respect and Tolerance

The Spanish curriculum at Endeavour Academy promotes the British Values of tolerance and mutual respect by:

- providing opportunities for pupils to discover new ways of thinking and gain an understanding of how life in other countries and cultures is different to our own;
- teaching pupils how to communicate their ideas and opinions about the other culture in a way
 that is purposeful and respectful. For example, they will learn how to describe people, places
 and things from Spain and explore the difference in culture, for example, through learning about
 the difference in school life or food.
- nurturing a 'have a go' culture, for example around pronunciation, giving pupils the confidence to make mistakes and learn from them.

Democracy

The Spanish curriculum at Endeavour Academy promotes the British Values of democracy by:

- enabling pupils to understand and communicate ideas, facts and feelings in Spanish speech and writing, focused on familiar and routine matters;
- encouraging pupils to express their views and preferences in Spanish about a variety of subjects, eg, what is your favourite food or what is your favourite subject;
- encouraging pupils to consider the views of others during their discussions.
