

    - Celebration time


# Snack

- All children are entitled to a free snack every session
  - Children can try a range of different fruit and vegetables.
    - Access to drinks at all time Milk & water
  - Please let us know if your child has any allergies or medical needs we should know about.

# Uniform

# Reading

- Every child will receive a library book by mid-September.
- These will be changed weekly. A letter will be sent in September.
- Lots of opportunities to come in and support your child with Reading throughout the year (COVID dependent) including workshops, book & biscuits & storytimes.
- Reading books will start to be sent home later in the Spring term.

# **Phonics**

- Floppy Phonics Scheme
- 1X Daily lessons 10-15 minutes per session
- Whole class session
- Practical and fun lessons
- Lots of chances to apply phonics in class learning and Literacy

### Home based activities

- Every child to receive home learning from week 2.
   This will be assigned on Microsoft Teams and you will upload pictures/videos of the home learning on a weekly basis. Staff will use this to send messages.
- Activities to be completed and returned to class by the following Thursday & linked to in class learning.
- Evidence Me will be used for sharing observations.
   More information on this will follow in September.
  - Class Dojo will be used for messages/information
