History and Geography

Hyde has been a significant town in local history for many years and may people have always lived in Hyde.

In 1887 the population of Hyde town was 17,876. In a census from 2011 we know that Hyde had 34,003 people living in it.

Discuss: Do you think there are more people in the past or today living in Hyde? Why do you think this is?

Most people in the past worked in the many factories that Hyde had, especially in the cotton mills. By 1939 most of the cotton mills had closed but the town created a large range of industries including rubber, leather, engineering, ice cream, chemicals and glove works.
