### Lemon Drizzle Cake



**Note:** This recipe involved baking in an oven. Adult supervision is required.

**What you will need:** See recipe

**Parents:** Choose a recipe to use - there are lots online or use the one attached below.

Prior to cooking discuss what your child needs to do (tie long hair back, wash hands, put on an apron).

First, talk about what you're going to make.

Second, look through the recipe together, make sure you have read each instruction carefully. Discuss what cooking skills you'll use stirring, squishing, breaking, greasing, backing etc.).

Third, follow the instructions step by step to make the cake. This is a good opportunity to practice measuring ingredients using maths skills.

Lastly, eat, enjoy and discuss what has worked or not in the recipe, or what changes you might make to personalise it for your family.

**Learning:** Food hygiene, cooking skills and reflecting on their work.

## Lemon Drizzle Cake



### Ingredients

225g self-raising flour

225g softened  
unsalted butter

225g caster sugar

4 eggs

grated zest 1 lemon

### For the drizzle topping

85g caster sugar

juice 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  lemons

### Equipment

Mixing bowl

Wooden spoon

Loaf tin (8 × 21cm)

Greaseproof paper


### Method

1. Preheat the oven to 180°C.
2. Mix the butter and caster sugar in a bowl and beat until creamy.
3. Add 4 eggs, one at a time and mix slowly.
4. Sift in 225g flour and add the lemon zest. Mix well.
5. Line the loaf tin with greaseproof paper, spoon in the mixture and level the top with your spoon.
6. Bake for 40-50 minutes, until a skewer inserted into the middle of the cake comes out clean. Leave the cake to cool in its tin.
7. Mix together the lemon juice and the caster sugar to make the drizzle.
8. Make holes in the top of the cake as evenly as you can and pour over the drizzle.
9. Leave the cake in the tin until completely cool. The cake will keep in an airtight container for 3 to 4 days.
