

Lemon Drizzle Cake



Note: This recipe involved baking in an oven. Adult supervision is required.

What you will need: See recipe

Parents: Choose a recipe to use - there are lots online or use the one attached below.

Prior to cooking discuss what your child needs to do (tie long hair back, wash hands, put on an apron).

First, talk about what you're going to make.

Second, look through the recipe together, make sure you have read each instruction carefully. Discuss what cooking skills you'll use stirring, squishing, breaking, greasing, backing etc.).

Third, follow the instructions step by step to make the cake. This is a good opportunity to practice measuring ingredients using maths skills.

Lastly, eat, enjoy and discuss what has worked or not in the recipe, or what changes you might make to personalise it for your family.
