Creative Challenge 1

Grown-up supervision

Japanese Hapa Zome prints?

This is a way of printing with leaves and flowers. You'll need to collect some colourful petals and leaves first. Once you have

done that you'll need a piece of material or a piece of paper. Now you need to arrange the petals and leaves on top of your material/paper. For the next bit your grown-up will need to help you to squash down the petals and leaves onto your material or paper (a hammer works best for this, but anything heavy will do). This should leave you with some beautiful prints. You might want to experiment with printing onto different materials and see which works the best.



Creative Challenge 2

Creative -Name Art

Take your pen or pencil for a walk, remembering not to take it off the paper. Fill each section with your name or a friend's name and colour in.



STEM Challenge 1

STEM –Butterfly feeder

What you'll need:

- 1 paper plate
- String
- Some over-ripe, rotten, mushy fruit.

1. Make four holes around the rim of your plate. Make sure they're equally spaced or your feeder will be lopsided!

2. Thread a piece of string through each hole and tie them off. Now tie the four ends together above the plate.

3. Place pieces of mushy fruit like bananas onto the plate.

4. Hang it up near some flowers and wait for the butterflies to flutter by.

STEM Challenge 2

STEM -Scavenger Hunt

Go on a scavenger hunt around your house/garden.

Find something that you can turn.

Find something bumpy.

Find something that is metal.

Find something that you put together.

Find 3 round things .

Find something that you twist.

Find something shiny.

Find something that rolls.

Find a tube.

Find 3 squishy things.

Find something that can bounce.
