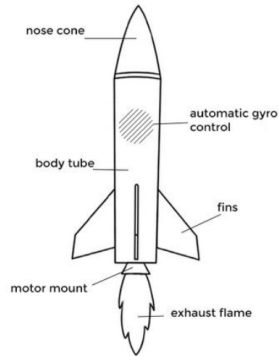
What kind of helmet does an astronaut wear?

Imagine you are going to space: you will need a helmet that has oxygen tubes and a big visor to see through. What things do you have around the house to make a helmet? Day 1- Reading

Thursday's Phonics: The 'ng' sound Watch Mr Thorne and Geraldine Giraffe learning the 'ng' sound again.

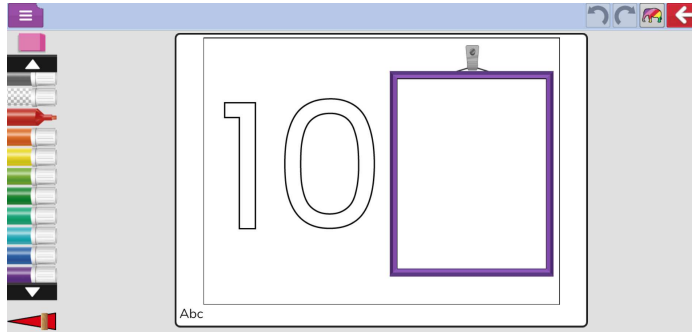

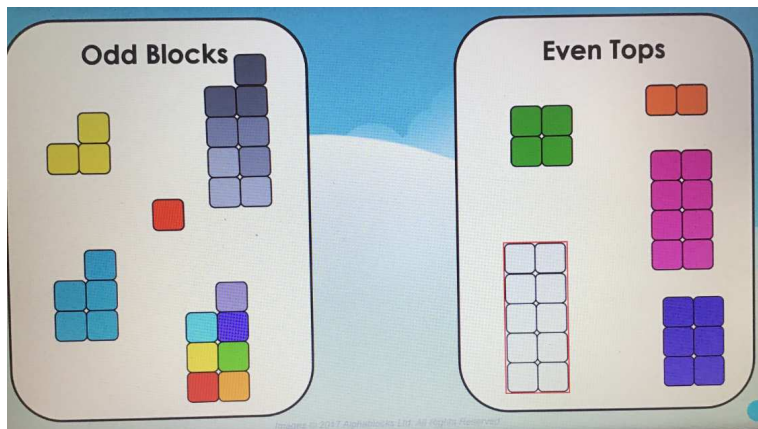
Monday 29th June 2020

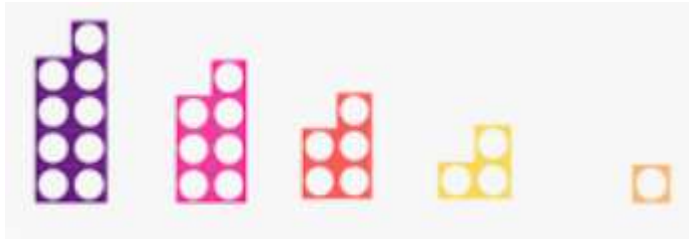


The Numberblocks get into two teams. Have you ever been in a team? What do you notice about the shapes of the Numberblocks in each team?

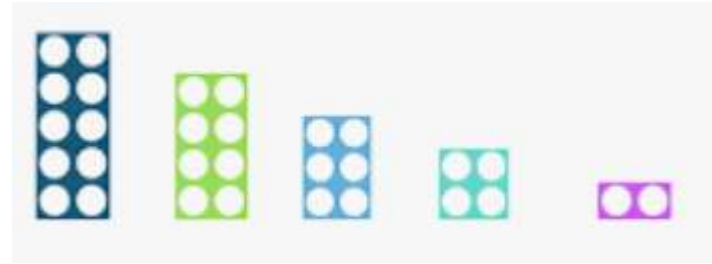


That's right, the Numberblocks in one team have an odd block on the top, and the Numberblocks on the other team have even tops.

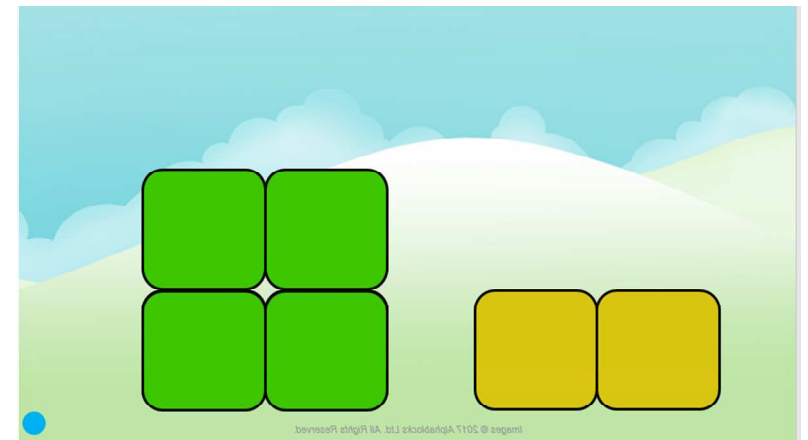
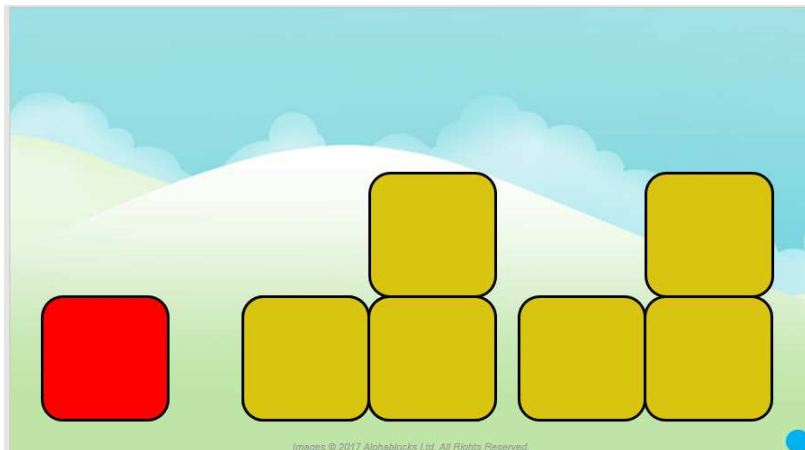

Are these Numberblocks **Odd** or **Even**?

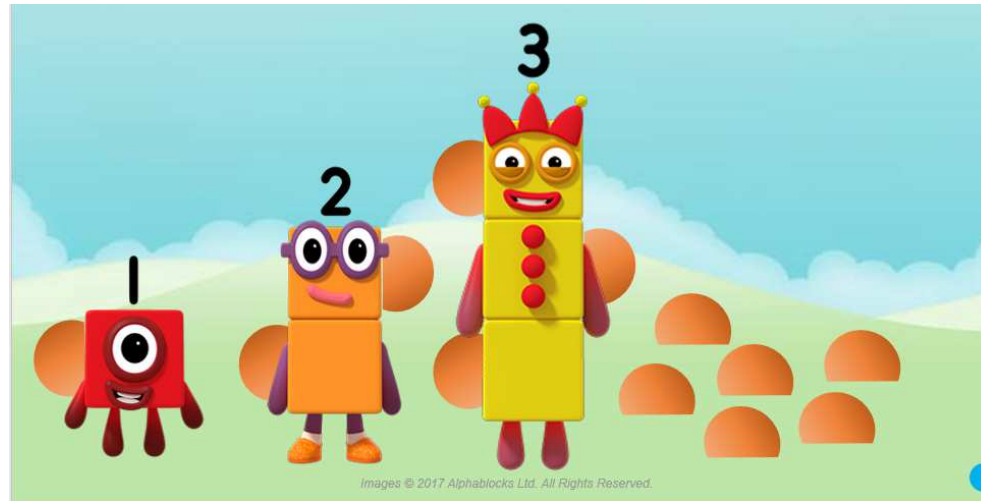

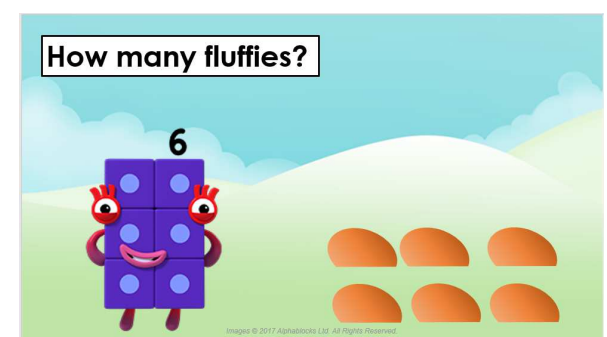
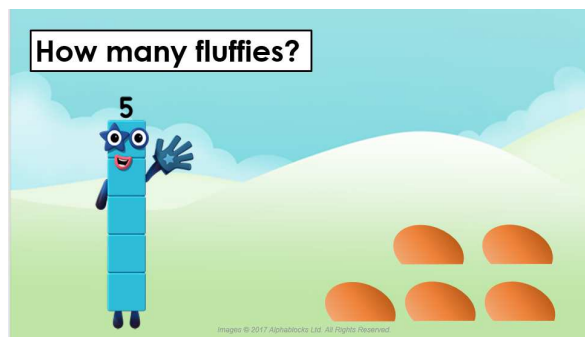
Watch the Numberblocks video called 'Count the Fluffies' .

That's right! **One** gets 1, **Two** gets 2 and **Three** gets 3.

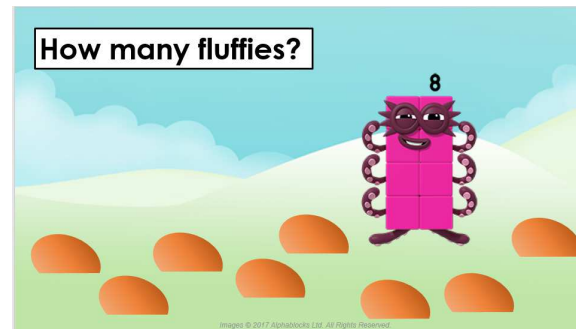
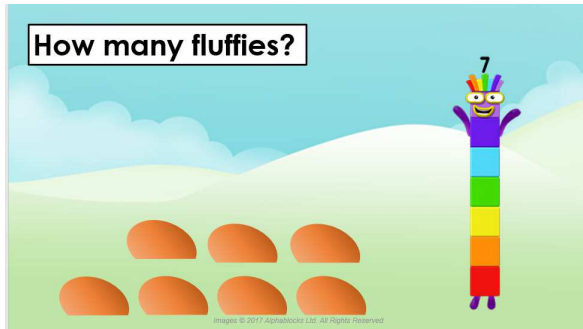

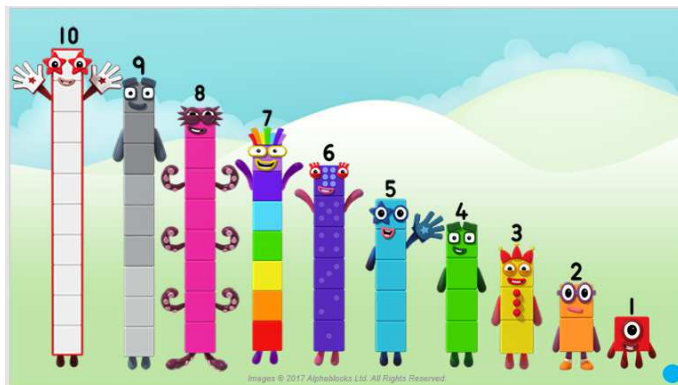

9 is **one less than** 10,

8 is **one less than** 9,

7 is **one less than** 8.....can you tell your adult the rest of this pattern?
