Your task:

Here are some ideas:

Who are you? Do you have any certificates, awards or badges?

Your home- what does it look like, what is in each room, how do you use each room?

Where do you live, could you include a map?

Who do you live with? (Include pets).

What are your hobbies/interests?

Who are your friends, how do you communicate with them during social distancing?

What is your school like- have you been to school during social distancing? Is it different now? What is school usually like?

What things can you do at the moment? Can you do all the things you usually do?

Ask an older relative or friend to make a bag too. You could share your bags with each other on a video-messaging app, or post photos on Teams for us all to see.
