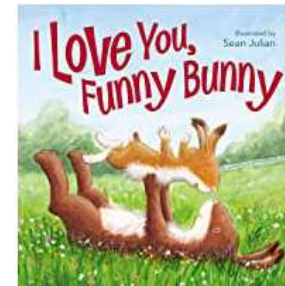

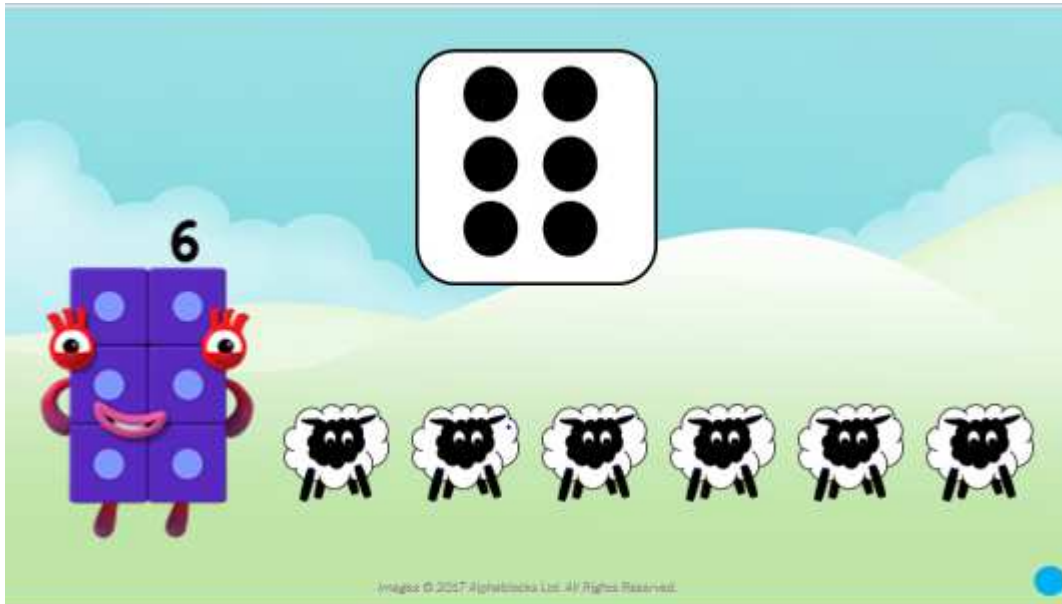

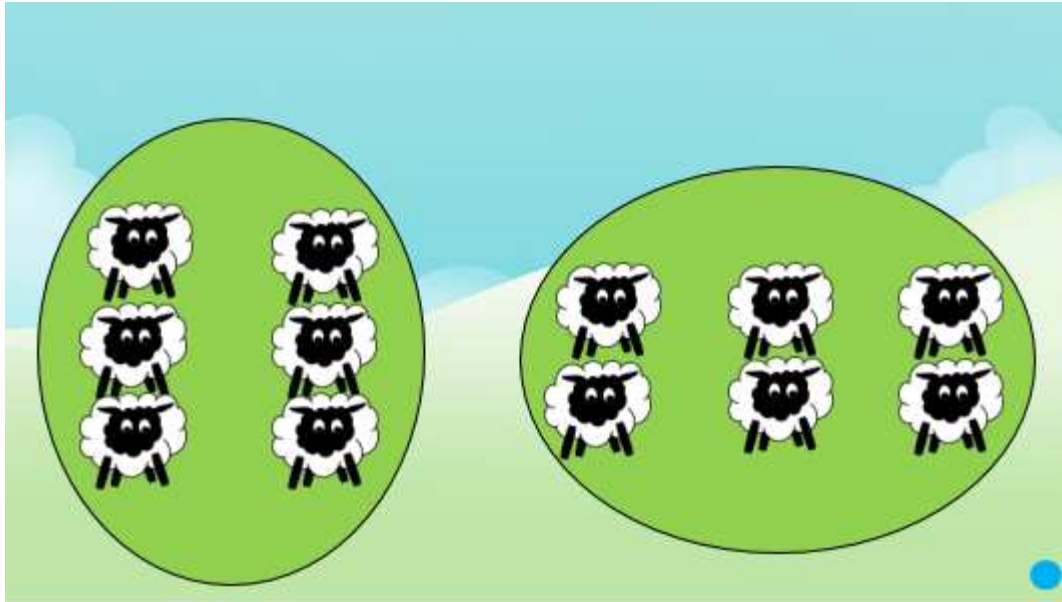

Six asks the sheep to make a group of 6. Can you think of **two** ways they can do this?



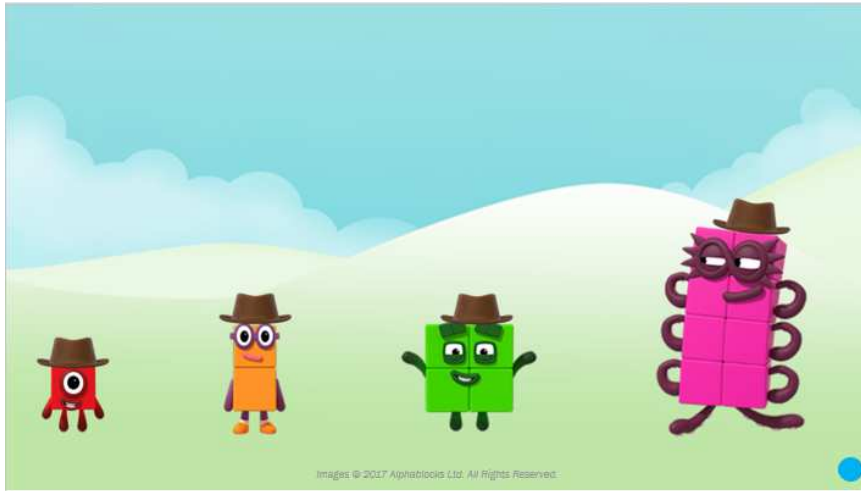
Here are the two ways the sheep made groups of 6.

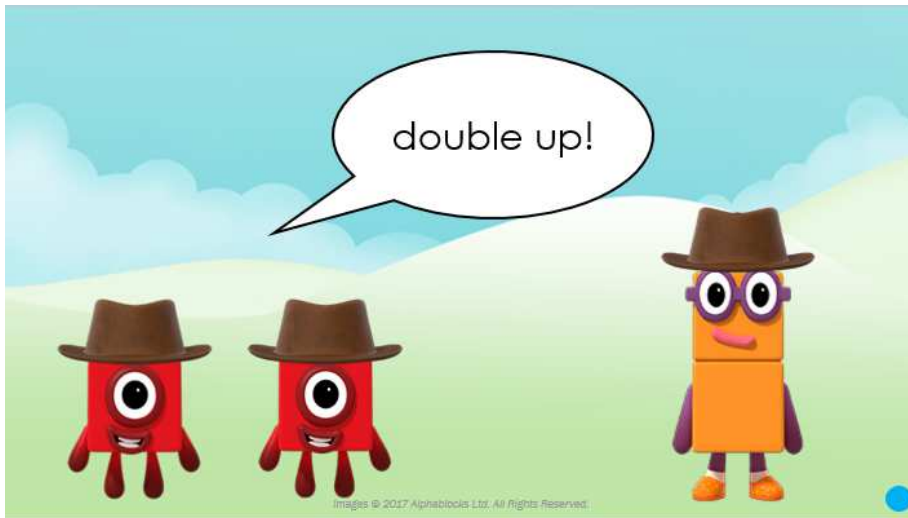

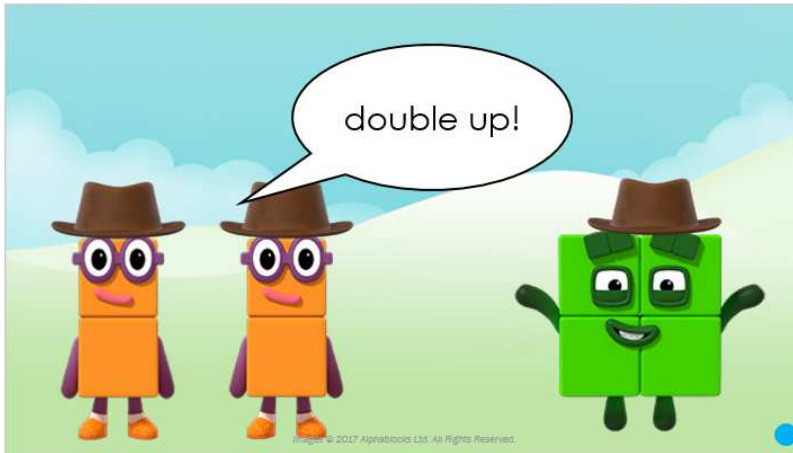


Who appeared in today's programme? Who didn't?

What happens when **One** and **One** double up?



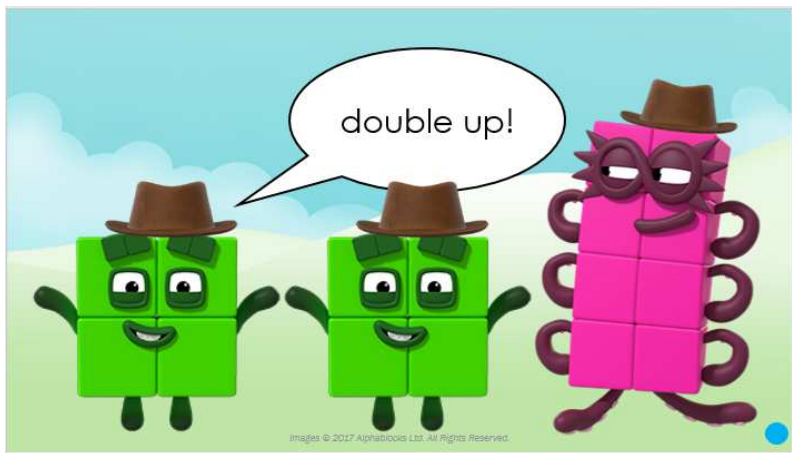
What happens when **Two** and **Two** double up?

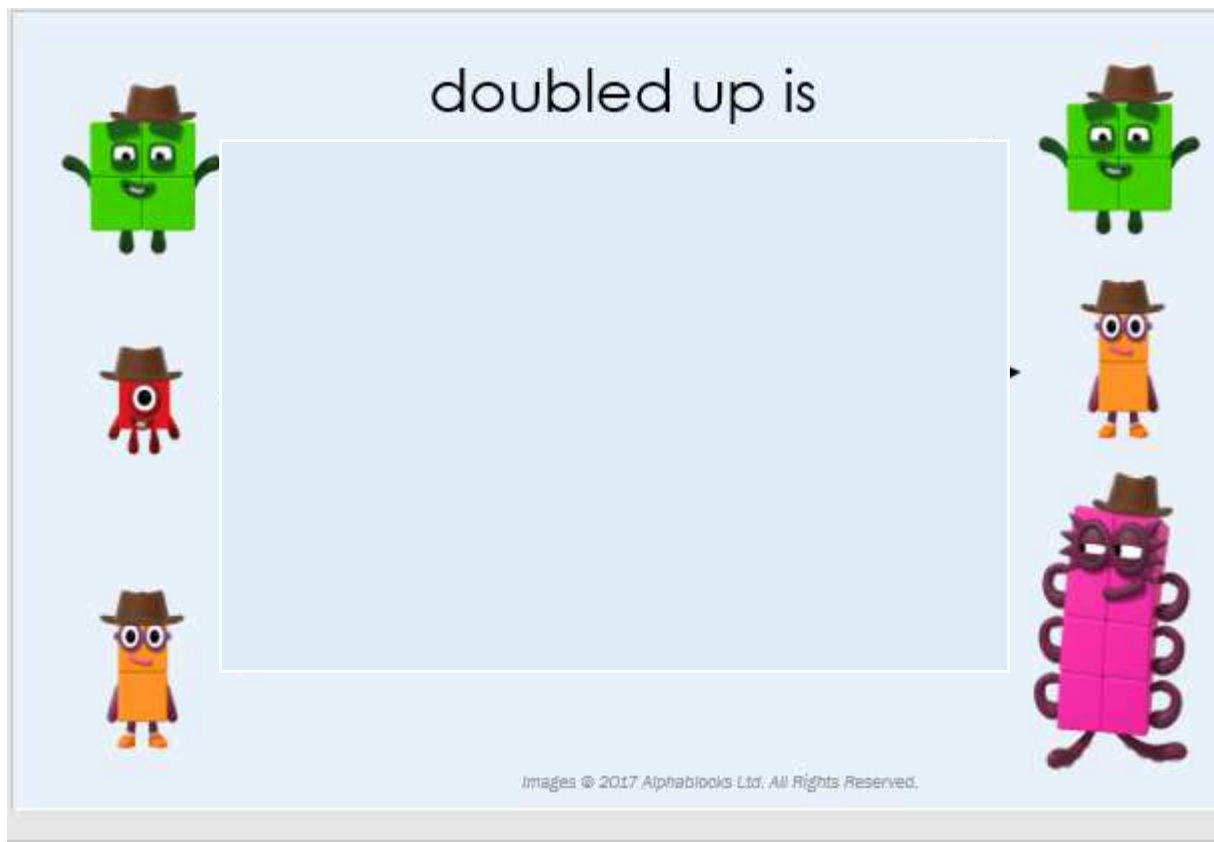

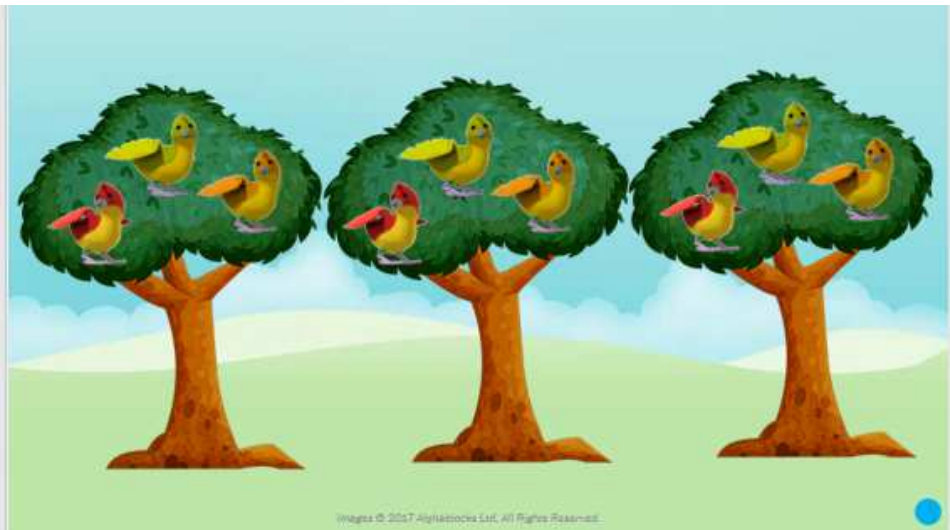

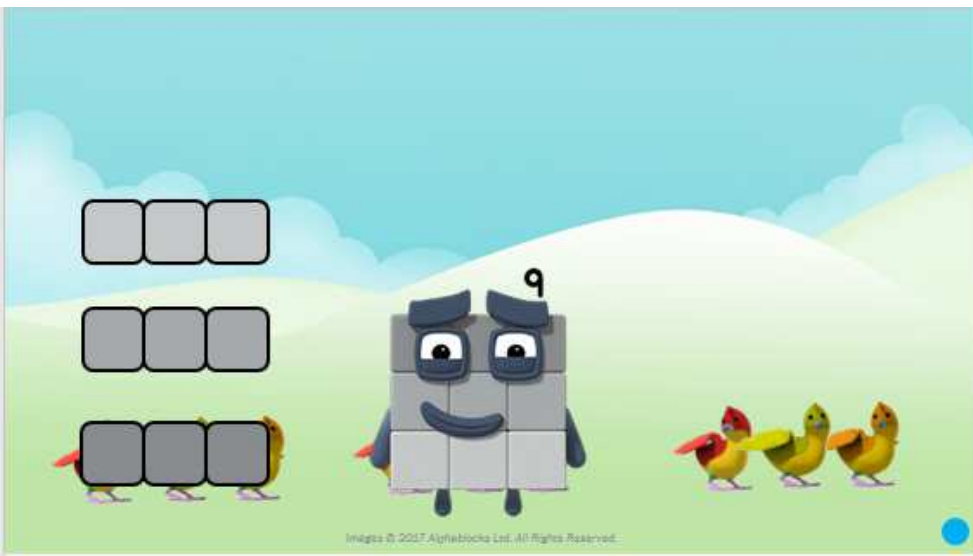
