Can you make your own masterpiece centred around the egg? Maybe you'll make Froz-egg or Minion Egg or maybe even 'a class of eggs'</p>	<p><b><u>Creative Challenge 3</u></b> Make something colourful out of paper   Cut and stick using junk such as boxes, tubes and packaging</p>
<p><b><u>STEM Challenge 1</u></b> Building Blocks Rainbow -We all need a rainbow right now. Can you use your bricks to make your own rainbow? Can you write an inspirational message?</p>	<p><b><u>STEM Challenge 2</u></b> Paper Planes – Can you make an airplane and see how far it travels? What happens if you use different thickness or different sized paper?</p>	<p><b><u>STEM Challenge 3</u></b> 5 Senses Scavenger Hunt – Look around your house &amp; garden. Can you find 3 items that you smell, that you can see, that you can hear, that you can taste and that you can touch.</p>

We would love to share it.</p>		<p><b><u>Musical Challenge</u></b> Choose your favourite nursery rhyme – Can you use an instrument to add accompaniment as you sing – Can you do it faster/slower?</p>
<p><b><u>Garden Challenge</u></b> Plant something and over the next few weeks, watch it grow: if you have no seeds or bulbs, you can grow a carrot top or the top of another vegetable on a saucer of water. In a week or two, when it has grown roots, you could plant it in some compost.</p>	<p><b><u>Garden Challenge</u></b> Can you come up with an Easter PE routine? For example you could do 10 bunny hops, 5 jumping frogs, 10 skipping sheep.</p>
